As we reflect on 2022, we see incredible growth and tremendous blessings. However, we can not say that the year was without its challenges. In fact, 2022 was our most difficult year yet.

In a presidential election year in Kenya, a sense of the unknown and being unsettled gripped the nation in 2022. As the political storm moved on, crushing inflation and fuel shortages swept in and continue to devastate the poorest and most vulnerable in the rural communities we serve.

Those challenges were somewhat anticipated and could even be considered typical sufferings that we occasionally walk through with our partners on the ground, particularly in a post-pandemic world. *What we didn't expect was to lose steadfast supporters and funding during our largest season of growth and need.*

Feelings of hopelessness and defeat gripped our team as rescue services for teens facing an acute crisis in Kilgoris were more needed than ever... but never felt so out of reach.

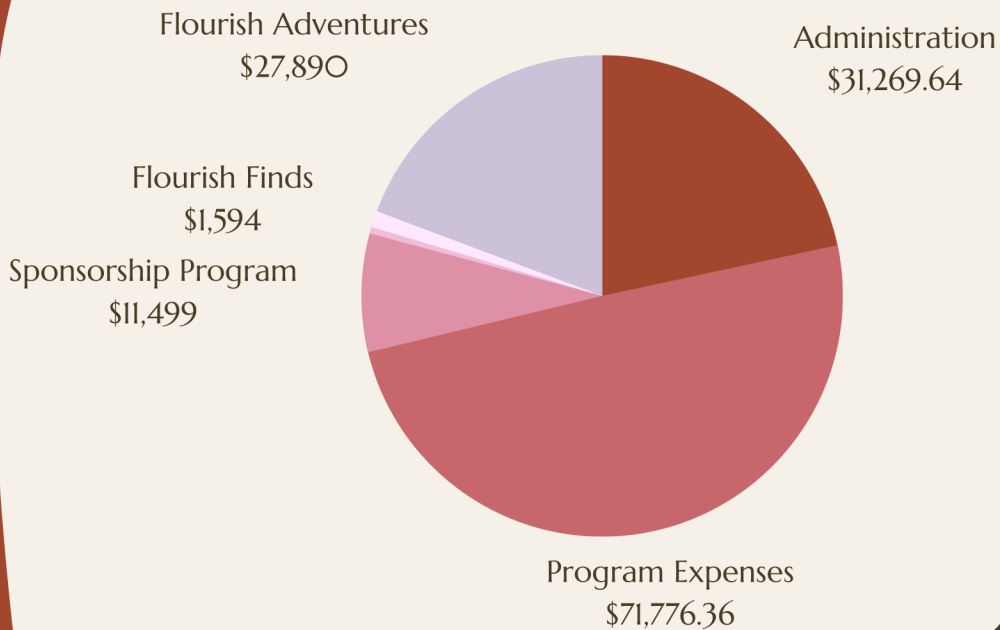

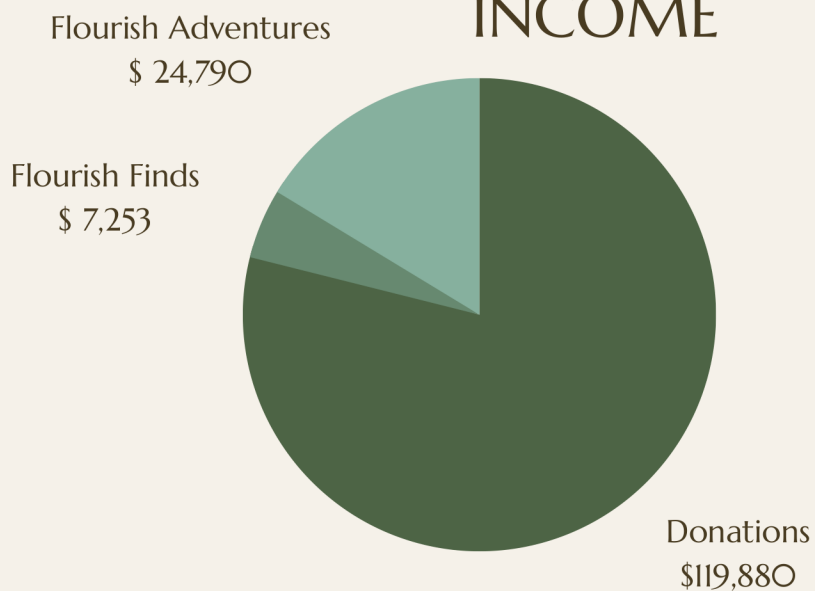
